

GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP IN EDUCATION CERTIFICATE

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Global Citizenship in Education is a Graduate Certificate program designed to equip educators with advanced knowledge and skills to internationalize the curriculum for PreK-16 students. This 12-unit program focuses on research, policy and practice in the field of global citizenship. The program culminates with a capstone project that creatively addresses an authentic problem in the education sector.

This Certificate may be combined with a master's or doctoral degree program to enhance your professional credentials. This option may be of particular interest to students in advanced degree programs such as Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, Secondary Education, Special Education, Gifted and Creative Education, Instructional Design, Educational Technology, Instructional Leadership, and Global Humanities.

The Post-Baccalaureate Certificate Program for Global Citizenship in Education is designed to enhance the knowledge and practice of educators who seek to prepare young people for active participation in the community and the world. It is grounded in the belief that education is a universal human right in an increasingly interdependent world. The primary aim of the program is to promote globally-competent educators who can equip their K-12 students with knowledge, skills, and dispositions to address issues of global significance.

Degree Requirements

The program requires completion of the following 12 units of course work and is designed to accommodate students with at least a baccalaureate degree, who are interested in internationalizing the school curriculum and programs.

3. demonstrate analytic skills by critiquing existing curricula/programs.
4. design original work that advances the field of global citizenship education and provides creative solutions for dissemination to authentic audiences.

- The curriculum allows students to earn a stand-alone certificate.
- Students may take select courses to advance their knowledge of global citizenship without enrolling in this program.
- The Post-Baccalaureate Certificate also may be earned in conjunction with a doctoral or master's degree program.
