

MAJOR IN SPORT MANAGEMENT

The Sport Management major is designed to prepare students for a changing sports industry. The curriculum develops critical and ethical sensibilities as well as practical skills with the intent of producing graduates who will be responsible business leaders and community advocates able to address commercial, economic, political and social issues related to sport.

Requirements

Program Requirements

The Sport Management major has 42 required units, and a required 24-unit Business Administration (BUAD) minor for a total of 66 units. Students completing a double major in Business Administration, Business Systems & Processes or Accounting complete the BUAD minor requirements through their second major and are not required to declare the minor to fulfill the Sport Management major requirements. Minimum 50% of the units required for the major must be completed at Towson University.
