Select four electives at the 200, 300 or 400 level:		12
Two of which must be at the upper level (300-400)		
FREN 201 and FREN 202 may be applied to the minor; however, students who have already completed a course at the 300 level may not register for lower-level courses		
Language minors may transfer up to 6 units toward a minor and must earn 6 upper-division units at Towson		
Courses should be selected in consultation with the student's minor adviser
